When God made the world with the Garden of Eden for Adam and Eve, He made it perfect for them to enjoy.

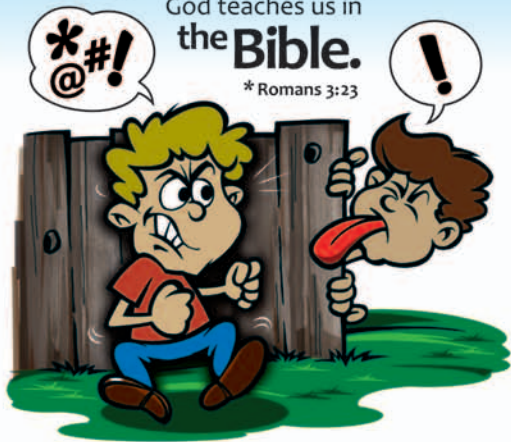
